International Society of Cardiology

The Council on Epidemiology and Prevention of the International Society of Cardiology announces its seventh 10-day international teaching seminar on cardiovascular epidemiology, to be held in Hungary 4-16 August 1974. Approximately 30 Fellows can be accepted. Final selection will be made by the Council's Seminar Committee. Nominees should be at the postdoctoral level, with some residency training or its equivalent, and be interested in cardiovascular epidemiology. Limited funds may be available to pay for room and board during the seminar and to give partial assistance with travel costs for accepted Fellows. *Fluency in English is essential.* Three documents are required for application: a letter of nomination submitted by chief of department

or institution, a personal letter of application from the nominee, and the applicant's curriculum vitae. These should be received before the deadline for applications, 1 May 1974. They should be sent to:
